The one God, in His/Her infinite compassion, takes on several forms (*Ishta Devata* – personal God) to fulfill the needs and aspirations of His/Her devotees. Sri Siva Vishnu Temple was founded on this principle of having several Ishta Devatas to meet the needs of a wide range of devotees. Worship of Ishta Devata and Kula Devata (Family Deity) is a special tradition to all Hindus. Supporting the rituals to various Deities according to one's choice and ability not only helps in maintaining this tradition, but it is recommended by the scriptures as one's duty. By supporting such activities in the temple, benefits accrue to the masses, and it sets a good example for future generations to follow.

Certain pujas are not conducive to be performed at home on a regular basis (ex. Siva Abhisheka, Padi Puja for Lord Ayyappa, or Butter Alankara for Lord Anjaneya) but are easily possible in a temple setting. Our scriptures place an emphasis on doing Pujas for the various deities on important days at the appropriate time (thithis); but due to schedules and other responsibilities, devotees may not be able to personally participate in these activities.

Supporting the worship of your Ishta Devatas on important days during the year has been made easy through the *Annual and Lifetime Sponsorship Program* at SSVT. Sponsorship of your favorite deities will ensure that Pujas are done on your behalf on special days regardless of if you are present on that day. These tax-deductible sponsorship donations are at a discount compared to sponsorship of individual programs during the course of the year. Annual sponsorships are valid for one year from the date of sponsorship. Lifetime sponsorships are valid in perpetuity and are deposited into the Sri Siva Vishnu Temple Endowment.


COVID-19 Operations

NAGA BHUSHAN MANDAVA

Dr. Naga Bhushan Mandava deceased on July 7, 2022 leaving behind his wife (Leela), Daughter (Santi), son (Srinivas). He was also the grandfather of 4 beautiful children who grew up under his nurturing and care.

Dr. Mandava was a world renowned scientist. He dedicated 24 years of public service to the USDA and EPA, and served as Director of United Nations Agencies (UNIDO, UNDP, FAO) to advise 15 countries in Asia and the Pacific Region on agricultural productivity and crop safety.



Sireesh Kumari Tripuraneni

Dr. Sireesh Kumari Tripuraneni passed away on July 20, 2022. She entered Rangaraya Medical College in 1963, and married Dr. Rajagopala Rao Tripuraneni in 1974. They both moved to the United States for post-graduate training and established a family with two children. Sireesh practiced internal medicine for 42 years at the Good Samaritan Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. She was beyond well-respected in the hospital; everyone knew Dr. Sireesh. Generations of families visited for annual exams, ailments, and some, just for a personal visit to receive her advice. Initially, she started her own practice, and she eventually joined the Good Samaritan Hospital practice.
