Tamil and Tulu New year are celebrated by worshiping the family deities, preparation of sweet and other delicacies and the reading of the Panchanga (Religious Almanac). The panchanga reading provides a list of all good and auspicious things as well as any adverse events that are likely to occur that year due to the transitory movements of planets as well as due to the presiding deity for the year. It is believed that listening to the panchanga reading will magnify the predicted good effects and mitigate the effect of adverse events. A unique feature of the celebration is the Sarva Devata Archana for all deities of our temple in sequence starting from 7:15 PM.

एकं सद्विप्रा बहुधा वदन्ति (Ekam Sat Vipraha Bahuda Vadanti) - Rig Veda (1.164.46) The truth is one; but the wise, talk of many.

The one God, in His/Her infinite compassion, takes on several forms (*Ishta Devata* – personal God) to fulfill the needs and aspirations of His/Her devotees. Sri Siva Vishnu Temple was founded on this principle of having several Ishta Devatas to meet the needs of a wide range of devotees. Worship of Ishta Devata and Kula Devata (Family Deity) is a special tradition to all Hindus. Supporting the rituals to various Deities according to one's choice and ability not only helps in maintaining this tradition, but it is recommended by the scriptures as one's duty. By supporting such activities in the temple, benefits accrue to the masses, and it sets a good example for future generations to follow.

Certain pujas are not conducive to be performed at home on a regular basis (ex. Siva Abhisheka, Padi Puja for Lord Ayyappa, or Butter Alankara for Lord Anjaneya) but are easily possible in a temple setting. Our scriptures place an emphasis on doing Pujas for the various deities on important days at the appropriate time (thithis); but due to schedules and other responsibilities, devotees may not be able to personally participate in these activities.

Supporting the worship of your Ishta Devatas on important days during the year has been made easy through the *Annual and Lifetime Sponsorship Program* at SSVT. Sponsorship of your favorite deities will ensure that Pujas are done on your behalf on special days regardless of if you are present on that day. These tax-deductible sponsorship donations are at a discount compared to sponsorship of individual programs during the course of the year. Annual sponsorships are valid for one year from the date of sponsorship. Lifetime sponsorships are valid in perpetuity and are deposited into the Sri Siva Vishnu Temple Endowment.

Please note - the temple will be closed during the Solar Eclipse on April 8, 2024 between the hours of 12:00 PM and 5:30 PM.

Holi Celebrations (April 7, 2024): Join us as we celebrate Holi on Sunday, April 7, 2024 at 11:30 AM. Organized by Trustee Jaishri Shankar, and the Education Committee, the program will kick off with the Sunday Family Dharma Class explaining the significance of Holi, followed by the celebration in the front parking lot. SSVT will provide the colors, please complete your darshan before participating! There will be dosa on the menu this Sunday too!

Ugadi, Vishu, Tamil and Tulu New Year (April 9 and April 13, 2024): Please note that Ugadi Day is on Tuesday, April 9. Srinivasa Kalyanam is scheduled for 7 PM with Panchanga Patanam, and distribution of Ugadi Pachadi and Prasadam. The festivities to celebrate Ugadi, Vishu, Tamil and Tulu New Year will be celebrated on Saturday, April 13. There will be a special lunch served between 11 AM and 3 PM on April 13, with a cultural program in the evening.

Ananthapadmanabha Mahotsavam (August 7-11): As I shared previously, in keeping with our temple tradition, we will be conducting a five-day grand Mahotsavam for Lord Ananthapadmanabha, from August 7th through August 11th. Discussions on finalizing the religious program are ongoing and will be finalized in the coming weeks. The first task force meeting will be held on April 6. Full details of the Mahotsavam will be shared soon!

SSVT Sai Mandir: The demolition of the old Balalaya was completed last month. Based on Engineering Committee recommendations, the old foundation will be removed and replaced with a new concrete foundation. The Bhoomi puja is scheduled for Sunday, April 14, at 11AM. It is expected to have substantial completion by October 2024. Additionally, the proposal to install Goddess Vasavi / Kanyaka Parameswari idol on the 2nd floor space was approved by the BOT

HVAC Replacement Project: Removal of the old HVAC equipment and installation of the new equipment has started. Please note, the rear lower level entrance in the dining hall has been closed to facilitate this work. This project is anticipated to be completed this Summer.

As always, we have a wonderful temple, but the aging infrastructure requires a fair amount of repairs, maintenance, or replacement.
