

## Sudarshana Jayanti (Maha Sudarshana Homa)

Saturday, August 10, 2024

(As part of the Sri Ananthapadmanabha Vaibhava Mahotsavam) Sudarshana, the holy discus (wheel) in the hands of Lord Narayana (Vishnu), is the embodiment of the power of Lord Vishnu in destroying the evil and protecting the righteous as he took the shape of the claws in Narasimha Avataram, arrows in Rama Avataram, axe in Parasurama Avataram and Chakra (wheel) in Krishna Avataram. Therefore, the worship of Sudarshana as a devata (deity) is extolled in Vaishnava agama Sastras. The worship of Sudarshana bestows good knowledge and good faculties as the syllable "Su" stands for "Good" and "Darshana" for "Vision". Our temple will be conducting a grand Sudarshana Homa followed by an Abhisheka on Saturday August 10, 2024. Devotees are encouraged to partcipate to recieve all the beneficial effects of worship of Lord Sudarshana.

#### Vishnu Pavitrotsavam

At the conclusion of this three-day ritual, Pavitram (Holy thread) that has been offered to the Lord is distributed as Prasadam to the sponsors.

#### Annual and Lifetime Puja Sponsorship

एकं सद्विप्रा बहुधा वदन्ति (Ekam Sat Vipraha Bahuda Vadanti) - Rig Veda (1.164.46) The truth is one; but the wise, talk of many.

The one God, in His/Her infinite compassion, takes on several forms (*Ishta Devata* – personal God) to fulfill the needs and aspirations of His/Her devotees. Sri Siva Vishnu Temple was founded on this principle of having several Ishta Devatas to meet the needs of a wide range of devotees. Worship of Ishta Devata and Kula Devata (Family Deity) is a special tradition to all Hindus. Supporting the rituals to various Deities according to one's choice and ability not only helps in maintaining this tradition, but it is recommended by the scriptures as one's duty. By supporting such activities in the temple, benefits accrue to the masses, and it sets a good example for future generations to follow.

Certain pujas are not conducive to be performed at home on a regular basis (ex. Siva Abhisheka, Padi Puja for Lord Ayyappa, or Butter Alankara for Lord Anjaneya) but are easily possible in a temple setting. Our scriptures place an emphasis on doing Pujas for the various deities on important days at the appropriate time (thithis); but due to schedules and other responsibilities, devotees may not be able to personally participate in these activities.

Supporting the worship of your Ishta Devatas on important days during the year has been made easy through the *Annual and Lifetime Sponsorship Program* at SSVT. Sponsorship of your favorite deities will ensure that Pujas are done on your behalf on special days regardless of if you are present on that day. These tax-deductible sponsorship donations are at a discount compared to sponsorship of individual programs during the course of the year. Annual sponsorships are valid for one year from the date of sponsorship. Lifetime sponsorships are valid in perpetuity and are deposited into the Sri Siva Vishnu Temple Endowment.

## Chairperson's Corner

Namaste Devotees!

While we hope everyone is enjoying the Summer with family vacations, college visits etc, we sincerely hope you will plan a visit to our temple with your family and friends! A lot of activities are going on at our temple in preparation and as part of the "Anantapadmanabha Vaibhava Mahotsavam". We completed devotee participatory pujas for Anantapadmanabha for four Saturdays. These pujas were very well attended and we thank you for your participation.

Following the devotee participation pujas, we had "Bhagavata Sapthaha Pravachanam" by renowned U.Ve. Dushyanth Sridhar from July 22 to July 28. The pravachanam was a great success with more overflow crowds each and every day. During the same time in the morning (6:30 to 11:30 AM) we had Bhagavata Sapthaha Parayanam by Sri Suresh Bhagavathar livestreamed from Chennai On Saturday July 20th, we celebrated Guru Purnima by conducting Sri Shirdi Sai Vratam including devotee participatory puja and Sai Bhajans. We also had two batches of Sri Satynarayana Śwamy Vratham and had excellent participation from our devotees. We invite all devotees and their families to participate in the Mahotsavams and to help SSVT thrive and prosper for our future generations. Our Acharyas will invoke the Divine blessings for one and all during this Mahotsavam. We will celebrate Mahotsavam from Wednesday, August 7 through Sunday, August 11, 2024. This Mahotsavam will be conducted by our Vaishnava Acharyas and the visiting Acharayas in Pancharatra Agama. They will be guided by Sri Samudrala Narasimhachari from Chicago. The highlight of the Mahotsavam will be the presence of Her Excellency Gouri Parvathi Bayi Thampuratti, Princess of Travancore and custodian of the Sri Anantha Padmanabha Swamy Temple in Thiruvananthapuram. There will be an interactive Q&A session with the Princess on August 10 at 6:00 PM in the SSVT Auditorium. Please check the temple website, social media and WhatsApp messages for full program and sponsorship details about the Mahotsavam. I personally invite you and your family and friends to participate in all events of the Mahotsavam, support generously (sponsorship link) and receive the Grace and Blessings of Sri Ánantapadmanabha.

With the installation of two new chillers, two new air handlers and fresh air intakes a major milestone for the HVAC replacement project was achieved. These systems provide cooling to about 80% of the main temple facility. Sai Mandir foundation and underground plumbing is complete and we are currently awaiting trade permits from WSSC Utilities. We expect the completion of Sai Mandir by end of this year with Baba Prana Pratishtapana after Sankranti.

Apart from the current construction projects, we do have a need for additional infrastructure improvements that include restroom renovation, auditorium facelift, kitchen and dining hall upgrades. As you may already know, we have the roof replacement and prakaram repairs also slated for this year. All these improvements pose a heavy financial burden on the temple and I request our congregation members to donate generously so that we can improve our infrastructure.

În the next three months, we invite you to participate in a number of religious events that include – Upakarma, Sravana Somvara (every Monday of August), Varalkshmi Vratam, Krishna Janmashtami, Sri Jayanti, Raghavendra Swamy Aradhana, Ganesh Chaturthi, Onam, Sarada Navaratri and Deepavali.

### Sarpabali

Sarpabali is the worship of 54 divine names (including Siva's Vasuki, and Vishnu's Adisesha) to ward off bad effects of Sarpa Dosha, help mitigate and eradicate skin diseases, help people search for life partners, for progeny, and the overall well-being of all. Sarpa Dosha is recognized when all the other grahas in one's horoscope lie between Raahu and Kethu. It is often a reason for late marriages. Turmeric powder, rice, milk, coconuts, fruits and flowers are the ingredients generally brought by devotees for Sarpabali. Sankalpam for the Puja will begin at 6:30 pm. Sarpabali Puja will be performed in Kerala Tantric style from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm.

#### Sarada Navaratri

*Thursday, October 3 - Saturday, October 12, 2024*Sarada Navaratri, as it is called since it occurs during the fall

sarada Navaratri, as it is caned since it occurs during the fair season (Sharad Ritu) is one of the most popular Hindu festivals spanning a period of nine nights. The Goddess in the form of the Universal Mother is commonly worshipped during the nine nights and ten days and hence it is also known by the name of Devi Navaratri. Three aspects of the Divine Mother, namely Durga, Lakshmi and Saraswati are worshipped during the nine nights, the tenth day being celebrated as Vijaya Dasami. It is considered auspicious to start new ventures, especially in the field of education, on Vijaya Dasami. Reading the Durga Sapta Shati (also known as Devi Mahaatmyam) and Ramayanam is also common during the Navaratri. Special Pujas are scheduled in the temple during the ten days. Devotees are encouraged to participate personally in the Sahasranama Archana daily. (Sponsorship is not a requirement for participation in this archana)
